

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF WINDERMERE, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 7.01.05 E (C) (4) PERTAINING TO FENCES, WALLS, AND POSTS; DELETING AND AMENDING LANGUAGE AS TO GATE TRANSPARENCY OF A FENCE OVER FOUR (4) FEET; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF WINDERMERE:

Section 1. Amending section 7.01.05 E (C) (4) of Article VII of the Land Development Code.

The Town Council hereby approves and adopts the following amendments and additions to section 7.01.05 E (C) (4) of Article VII of the Town of Windermere's Land Development Code as indicated by the underline and strikethrough language:

7.01.05: Fencing Standards

E. Standards.

(c) Maximum Height.

4. Gates shall be no higher the 60 inches from the ground and the highest point on the gate, including its decorative elements, shall not exceed the height of the adjoining wall or fence by more than 12 inches and no more than 60 inches from the ground in the front yard. Maximum height of a gate in the side and rear yard is to correspond to the fence height. ~~A gate over 48 inches shall have 50% transparency~~
Any gate attached to a fence that is required to be 48 inches or less is required to be 50% transparent.


Section 2. Severability. If any provision or portion of this ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this ordinance shall remain in full effect.

Section 3. Codification. The amendments in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be codified and made part of the official Land Development Code of the Town of Windermere.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect immediately upon its enactment.


Persons with disabilities needing assistance to participate in this proceeding should contact the Town Clerk 48 hours before the meeting.
