ADDENDUM MESSAGE

The following clarifications and/or changes become hereby a part of this bid and shall be included in the Contractor's Bid Prices:

Questions received:

Q1: Bid Item 1 (101-1) states "5% of Stormwater Improvements." Should this read "5% of Milling and Resurfacing Improvements," as stated in the Contract?

A1: Yes it should be "5% of Milling and Resurfacing Improvements." The pay item description was a clerical error and is corrected in the attached revised Bid Form.

Q2: The Bid Form does not provide an Item for Inlet Protection. Please advise.

A2: Include as part of Mobilization/Demobilization. Minimal drainage in development. All drainage contained within development.

Q3: Where are the millings to be delivered? The bid documents state "site determined by Town." We need to know the location to determine delivery price.

A3: The Town has not decided on a location. At this time, refer to Addendum No. 2 regarding how to bid this item.

Q4: Are temporary pavement markings required for this project?

A4: No temporary markings are required.

Q5: What is the Engineer's Estimate?

A4: \$155,000.

- Q6: Can the Engineer and Town reevaluate the limitation of pre-milling?
A6: The limitations stated in General Note No. 27 can be waived since the project is within a residential development with the streets being only one lane in each direction. Traffic is allowed on the milled surface.
- Q7: Where is the 200 SY of Performance Turf and muck blanket? The typical sections do not indicate Index 105 Sod Treatment. Index 105 does not require muck or prepared soil layer per FDOT requirements. Please advise.
A7: This is primarily a contingency item in the event any of the sodding along the neighborhood is disturbed/damaged either by equipment or any other incidental construction. This is a well maintained neighborhood with expensive homes and the performance turf is included to offset that incidental construction.
- Q8: Note 3 of the General Notes requires disposal of excess earthwork. Please confirm that earthwork is not part of this Contract.
A8: No earthwork is a part of this project. This is a standard general note on all Town plans.
- Q9: Note 6 requires all slopes 3:1 or steeper to be sodded. Please confirm that earthwork and grading are not part of this Contract.
A9: No earthwork or grading is a part of this project. This is a standard general note on all Town plans.

It is understood that where quantities for unit price work have been presented in the foregoing Schedule of Bid Items, they are approximate only and are solely for purpose of facilitating the comparison of bids, and that the Contractor's compensation will be computed upon the basis as described in the measurement and payment clauses in the specifications contained herein.

10. BASE BID - SCHEDULE OF MANUFACTURERS/SUPPLIERS

The undersigned as Bidder agrees that the Contract, if awarded, will be on the basis of the materials and equipment named in the Contract Documents in accordance with Article 9 of the Instructions to Bidders. The undersigned as Bidder also agrees that the Bidder will provide one of the listed manufacturers/suppliers. 11. SUBSTITUTIONS AND "OR EQUAL"

The undersigned as Bidder agrees that substitutions or "or-equal" items will not be considered until after the "Effective Date of the Agreement" and will be evaluated in accordance with paragraphs 6.7.1, 6.7.2, and 6.7.3 of the General Conditions. In addition to the reimbursement required under the General Conditions, the Contractor shall also reimburse the Owner for any engineering costs directly attributable to the change in manufacturers/suppliers, caused by the acceptance of proposed alternates, such as; additional field trips for the Engineer, additional redesign costs, and additional review costs, etc. Other costs directly attributable to the change in manufacturers/suppliers caused by the acceptance of proposed alternates, such as; increased electrical requirements, larger building, additional pumps or tankage, etc., shall be borne by others and not the Owner. The Owner may request, and the undersigned Bidder shall supply, complete information on proposed substitutions. Such information shall be the manufacturer's current published or preprinted information for the specific substitution.
