RESOLUTION 2008-16

A RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN OF WINDERMERE, FLORIDA TO ENTER INTO AN HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANT MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DIVISION OF HISTORICAL RESOURCES, BUREAU OF HISTORIC PRESERVATION, FOR A SMALL, MATCHING GRANT IN ORDER TO RESTORE AND RELOCATE THE TOWN'S 1890 SCHOOL HOUSE

WHEREAS, the preservation of our historic buildings is an important part of our community; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Windermere wants to maintain its buildings that are on the National Registry of Historic Places; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Windermere desires to apply for a 2008 Small Matching Grant, which would provide monies to help fund the relocation and restoration of the 1890 school house; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Windermere wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement between the Town of Windermere, and the Florida Division of Historical Resources;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Windermere, Florida:

Section 1. The Town Council supports the Windermere Historical Board's efforts to obtain state funds to restore and relocate the Town's 1890 school house.

Section 2. The Town Council hereby authorizes the Town Manager to enter into a Grant Memorandum of Agreement between the Town of Windermere, Florida and the Florida Division of Historical Resources.
