ADDENDUM MESSAGE

The following clarifications and/or changes become hereby a part of this bid and shall be included in the Contractor's Bid Prices:

The following are responses to questions received by the Town:

1. Please confirm if the new signs post is to be standard aluminum or need to be epoxy coated like the beacon signs.

Only the RECTANGULAR RAPID FLASHING BEACON (Pay Item No. 654-2-21) will be epoxy coated. The rest of the signs will be standard aluminum.

2. Will the noise restriction be held to as per specs? Levels by the equipment may be greater than 85 dB and 55 dB by the homes as they pass.

The residents will be notified in advance of the work regarding and disturbance, including noise. During working hours, the noise should be held to the minimum as practicably possible. It is understood that the noise levels may be exceeded, which is permissible, but as long as it is not on a continuous and lengthy period of time. This will be monitored by the Contractor and the Town as best as possible keep construction noise at a minimum.



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3. Please confirm if the trees shown on Lillypad Lane are to be removed (not labeled on the plans).

These trees are to be removed and the total plan quantities on the Bid Form already include the number of trees on Lillypad Lane to be removed. The plans will be CONFORMED to reflect those trees to be removed and will be included with the ISSUED FOR CONSTRUCTION plans that will be issued to the contractor awarded the bid.

4. There is a tree removal item 580-5-4, please clarify what scope is to be included in Arborist Item 110-15.

The tree removal pay item is specifically for the trees already identified to be removed. The ARBORIST WORK (COMPLETE) scope is outlined in the Project Manual under DIVISION 1 – SECTION 01025 – MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT, Part 3, F. Bid Item No. 6 – ARBORIST WORK (COMPLETE). The Arborist work is intended to provide the Town with advice on any other tree work beyond the trees already identified for removal (Pay item No. 580-5-4 TREE REMOVAL, STUMP GRINDING AND DISPOSAL). Please review this section for consideration of your bid.
